Welcome back! We are off to a great start, and have high hopes that this will be an incredible school year!

We are excited to begin a new year and academically grow our students. Sagewood is showing 83% of students are reading at or above grade level based on NWEA MAP assessment. In addition, 87% of students are at or above grade level in math based on the NWEA MAP assessment. We are seeking to reach our goal of 100% of students at or above grade level.

Sagewood is a safe place for all children. We will ask all visitors to sign in at the front office before, during and after school. When a child needs picked up early, we will call the child to the office. Visits to the classroom during school hours should be scheduled in advance. This is designed to keep hallways safe and learning a priority for all children.
