Welcome back! We are off to a great start, and have high hopes that this will be an incredible school year!

We are excited to begin a new year and academically grow our students. Sagewood is participating in many new changes from the district and school level. You will be hearing about our classroom management tool called the TOOLBOX as well as our reading comprehension tool called the TOOLKIT. Students will no longer take NWEA MAP testing, but will instead participate in the statewide WY-TOPP assessment. In addition, other assessments such as Lit-First and AIMS will phase out for FASTBRIDGE.

Sagewood is a safe place for all children. We will ask all visitors to sign in at the front office before, during and after school. When a child needs picked up early, we will call the child to the office. Visits to the classroom during school hours should be scheduled in advance. This is designed to keep hallways safe and learning a priority for all children.
