Dress for winter

With the onset of winter weather, we'd like to remind everyone of the importance of wearing appropriate outerwear. Whenever possible, students will be outside for recess. Students should exit the building with their coats, hats, gloves, etc. Students who choose to go outside without a coat may be sent back inside for their coats when the temperature is below 40 degrees.

The Natrona County Health Board provides us guidance when the air temperature and windchill combine to produce a temperature between 0 and 10 Fahrenheit, or wind speeds exceed 30 mph, recess will be 10 minutes or less. When the temperature is below 0, students will have indoor recess.

Please let us know if you are in need of assistance in providing coats, hats or gloves for your children so that we can help you connect with agencies that have those resources.

Nurse's Notes:

Winter is here in Wyoming. As above please have your children dress warm for our weather. If your child is in need of a winter coat, hats, gloves or boots. Please let me know. I have had a lot of donations this year.

As you go through your child's clothes would you consider donating, any size 5-8 pants in boys or girls to the school nurse. I go through these sizes the most, for students who have accidents at school or get their clothes wet or muddy.

Thank you in advance for all donations.

Remember this is cold and flu season, please be sure you and your child get your flu vaccine.

Encourage your child to practice good hand-washing throughout the year.
