Closing the Year

- We will be sharing with students who their next year's teacher will be on June 1st this year. Students will have 30 – 45 minutes on June 1st where they get to spend that time with their next teacher.
- Class lists will continue to be updated over the summer months.
- **Report cards will be sent home on June 7th.** Report cards will not be available prior to that date. A reminder that learning continues through the last day of school. Even when some learning events are a different approach than a typical day (ie field trip), we are still committed to maximizing learning time. Thank you for ensuring your child is in attendance for all days.
- **Please arrange to pick up your child's medication on or before June 7th.** District policy is that we don't send home medications with the children and we don't store medications over the summer. Medications not picked up will be discarded.

Lunch Notes

A reminder from the lunchroom:

There will be no more charges allowed for breakfast or lunch for the remainder of the school year. Children need to have money on their account or cash in hand to eat meals at school. They are also welcome to bring lunches from home. (This also applies to breakfast.) We will be asking students to call home at morning recess if there is a negative balance on their account and they have not brought money or a lunch from home, this is in order to reconcile our lunch budget before the end of the year.

The totals until the end of the year (as of June 1st) are:

- \$8.25 – full price breakfast
- \$13.75 – full price lunch
- \$1.50 – reduced breakfast
- \$2.00 – reduced lunch
