As you know each month we are expected to practice safety drills. The past two months we have completed fire drills and this month we will be practicing another ALICE drill. The plan this month is to practice the shelter in place portion of ALICE. In each classroom they will be discussing what would cause them to shelter vs. leaving the building.

Just a couple reminders as we continue this third quarter of school. Our supervision after school for students is in the back of the school. If your child walks around the sidewalk to meet you there is one staff member supporting students around the parking lot exits but is not out front to supervise students waiting there. If you are going to be late to pick up simply call the office and we will let the staff outside for them to tell your child so they are not searching/ waiting outside of the gate.

Another area I want to cover is attendance. Our attendance rates at Sagewood overall are great and we appreciate all the work that parents/ guardians do to get their students to school daily and on time. We understand that absences are going to happen and a big thank you to those who are providing doctors notes for absences that they cover. In alignment with the district attendance regulation our office sends five, ten and fifteen day letters to parents/guardians. Regardless of the type of absence if your child has five, ten or fifteen days you will receive this letter. The purpose of this is to ensure that all parents have an understanding of their child's current attendance status. If you ever have a concern about the letter and would like to discuss it please contact the office and I would be more than happy to support you.

Thank you for sharing all your amazing kids with us and allowing us to be part of their learning and lives. Sagewood is a great community that I am thankful to be part of.
